STUDENT ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES (SAS)

Under the guidelines of The Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, Student Accessibility Services (SAS) provides a range of services to students with documented or verifiable disabilities. Reasonable accommodations are provided in the academic setting to allow a person with a disability to participate equally and fully.

Student Accessibility Services (SAS) is committed to creating a positive and supportive student experience at Lorain County Community College and providing equal access to an educational experience through academic accommodations. Staff members determine reasonable academic accommodations for students based upon recommendations from licensed professionals who diagnosed the student's disability. Staff also consider accommodations that were previously used by the student in an educational setting.

All prospective students with disabilities are encouraged to contact Student Accessibility Services (SAS) in the early stages of their college planning. The admissions process for students with disabilities is the same as for all other students. Disclosure of the disability is voluntary.
